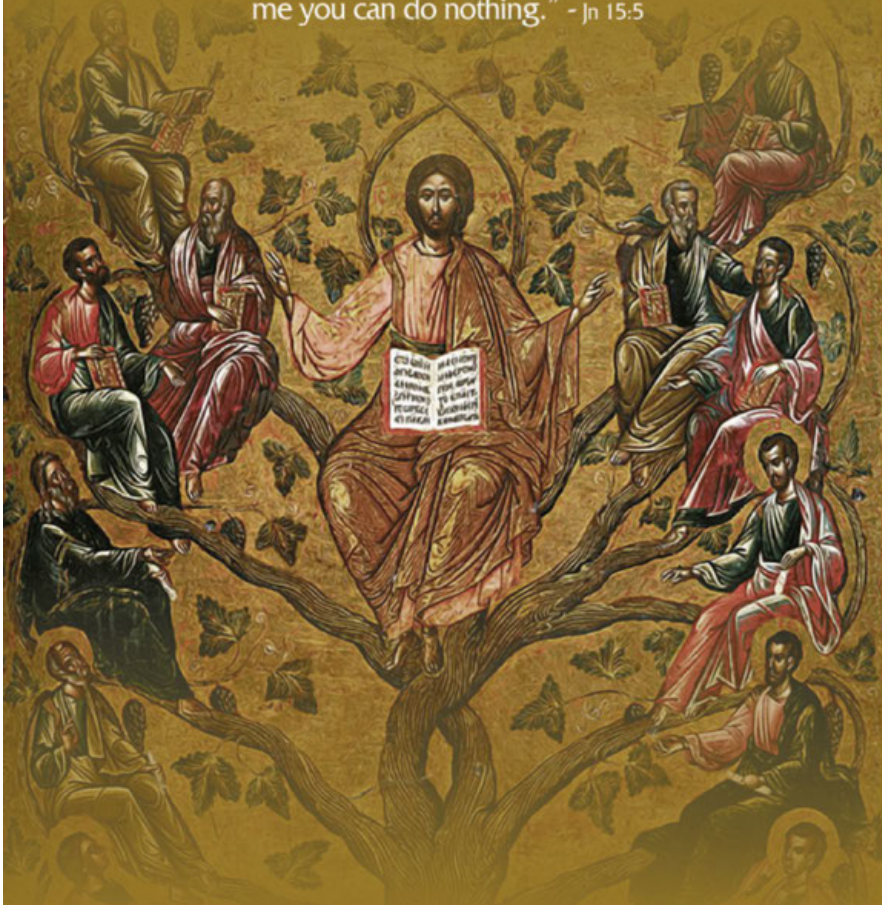

Dear Parishioners,

It is the 5th Week of Easter already, and the Church is looking toward the culmination of the Easter season at Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit comes in power upon the Church. I'd like to take the opportunity to share with you some observations about the importance of Pentecost, and some of the things we are preparing for its celebration, while we are a few weeks out. For one thing, we need to know that the Church has always regarded Pentecost as one of the highest feasts of the liturgical year, ranking up there with Easter, and

arguably higher than Christmas!

What a lot of people don't know, because they've never experienced it, is that Pentecost has an actual "Vigil Mass." Not just a Saturday Mass that counts for the Sunday obligation and is called a 'Vigil Mass,' while it is only a Mass anticipating the Sunday obligation. A real Vigil Mass, like the "Easter Vigil," or the "Christmas Vigil Mass," or the Vigil of the Assumption, is a Mass with its own set of readings and prayers, which actually begins the celebration of the feast the evening before, and doesn't merely anticipate it.

If you do some studying of the Daily Missal, you will find that for the Feast of Christmas, there are actually four separate Christmas Masses, each with a unique set of readings and prayers, aligned with the time they are offered: hence, there is a Vigil Mass, a Midnight Mass, a Mass at Dawn, and Mass of the Day. Again, on Easter, the readings and prayers of the Easter Vigil Mass differ entirely from the readings and prayers of the Mass of the Easter Day.

Well, Pentecost, too, has a real "Vigil Mass," and I expect most of us have never gotten to experience it; I know I haven't! I am looking forward to encountering the Pentecost Vigil, in all its glory, with you at the 5:00pm Mass on Saturday, May 18. More info coming, but just to start getting the word out. Many prayers and blessings on the week!

Estimados feligreses,

Ya es la quinta semana de Pascua y la Iglesia espera la culminación del tiempo Pascual en Pentecostés, cuando el Espíritu Santo venga con poder sobre la Iglesia. Me gustaría aprovechar la oportunidad para compartir con ustedes algunas observaciones sobre la importancia de Pentecostés y algunas de las cosas que estamos preparando para su celebración, mientras faltan algunas semanas. Por un lado, debemos saber que la Iglesia siempre ha considerado a Pentecostés como una de las fiestas más importantes del año litúrgico. Incluso, tan importante como la Pascua y ¡posiblemente más importante que la Navidad!

Lo que mucha gente no sabe, porque nunca lo ha experimentado, es que Pentecostés tiene una "Misa de Vigilia". No solo una Misa del sábado que cuenta para la obligación dominical y se llama "Misa de Vigilia," mientras que es solo una Misa que anticipa la obligación dominical. Una verdadera Misa de Vigilia, como la "Vigilia Pascual," la "Misa de Vigilia de Navidad" o la Vigilia de la Asunción, es una Misa con su propio conjunto de lecturas y oraciones, que en realidad comienza la celebración de la fiesta la noche anterior, y no simplemente la anticipa.

Por ejemplo, para la Fiesta de Navidad, en realidad hay cuatro Misas de Navidad separadas, cada una con un conjunto único de lecturas y oraciones, alineadas con el tiempo en que se ofrecen: por lo tanto, hay una Misa de Vigilia, una Misa de medianoche, una Misa de madrugada y una Misa del día. Nuevamente, en Pascua, las lecturas y oraciones de la Misa de la Vigilia Pascual difieren completamente de las lecturas y oraciones de la Misa del Día de Pascua.

Bueno, Pentecostés también tiene una verdadera "Misa de Vigilia", y supongo que la mayoría de nosotros nunca hemos llegado a experimentarla; ¡Sé que yo no lo he hecho! Espero experimentar con la Vigilia de Pentecostés, en todo su esplendor, con ustedes en la Misa de las 5:00 p.m. el sábado 18 de mayo. Más información próximamente, pero solo para comenzar a correr la voz. ¡Muchas oraciones y bendiciones en la semana!

A Reflection on the Gospel

"I am the vine, you are the branches."

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us of a very important fact using an analogy that the people of the time would've clearly understood. Have you ever seen a vineyard? The vast rows of vines with branches, perhaps some filled with grapes and others without?

Using the analogy of the vine and branches, Jesus is saying that he is the vine and we, the faithful, are the branches. Without him, we cannot exist, we cannot grow, we cannot become the fruit of the vine. And, like a caretaker of the vineyard, when a branch no longer produces fruit, it is cut away so that the resources of the vine may pour into the branches that remain fruitful and produce its goodness.

Jesus does not mince words. He makes clear the message he wants understood, not just by those in his presence listening to him speak, but just as importantly, those of us who hear his words today: "Remain in me, as I remain in you." Without him, we can do nothing. With him, we can do all things.

As it is said in Sacred Scripture, "The harvest is full, but the laborers are few." Will you remain in him, and allow him to remain in you? Are you ready to grow and be fruitful? Are you ready to get to work and fulfill the purpose for which God created you?

Let's get to work!

Una Reflexión Sobre el Evangelio

"Yo soy la vid, vosotros sois los pámpanos".

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos recuerda un hecho muy importante utilizando una analogía que la gente de la época habría entendido claramente. ¿Alguna vez has visto un viñedo? ¿Las vastas hileras de enredaderas con ramas, quizás algunas llenas de uvas y otras sin ellas?

Usando la analogía de la vid y los pámpanos, Jesús está diciendo que él es la vid y nosotros, los fieles, somos los pámpanos. Sin él, no podemos existir, no podemos crecer, no podemos convertirnos en fruto de la vid. Y, como un cuidador de la viña, cuando un sarmiento ya no produce fruto, es cortado para que los recursos de la vid se derramen en los sarmientos que quedan fructíferos y producen su bondad.

Jesús no se anda con rodeos. Él deja claro el mensaje que quiere que lo entiendan, no sólo aquellos que están en su presencia escuchándolo hablar, sino igualmente importante, aquellos de nosotros que escuchamos sus palabras hoy: "Permaneced en mí, como yo permanezco en vosotros". Sin él, no podemos hacer nada. Con él podemos hacer todas las cosas.

Como dice la Sagrada Escritura: "La mies está llena, pero los trabajadores son pocos". ¿Permanecerás en él y permitirás que él permanezca en ti? ¿Estás listo para crecer y ser fructífero? ¿Estás listo para ponerte manos a la obra y cumplir el propósito para el cual Dios te creó?

¡Pongámonos a trabajar!
