

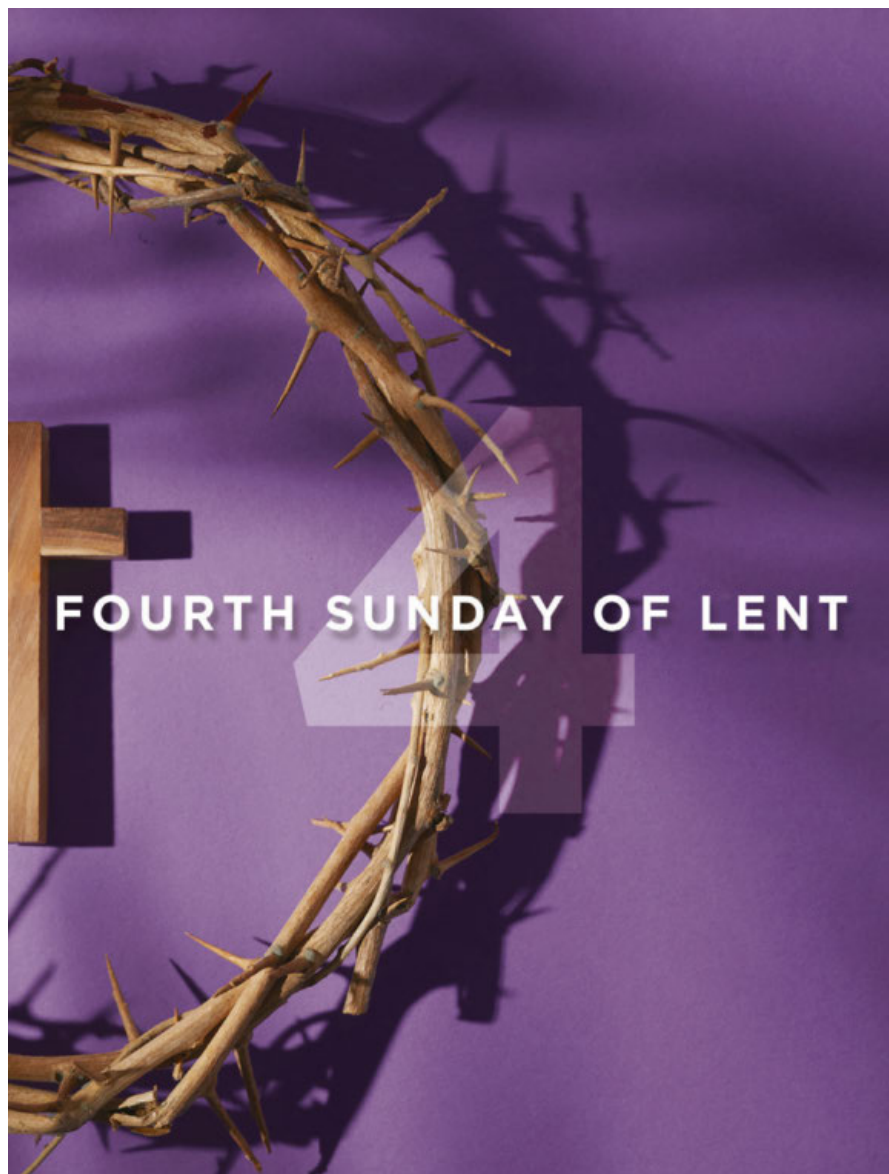

A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR / UNA NOTA DE NUESTRO PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

A blessed Lent to all! Please make sure you make the Sacrament of Confession a priority between now and Easter. Don't wait until the last minute either. We have Confessions six days a week and St. John Catholic Student Center has a robust schedule as well.

I want to give an update on the old St. Francis Xavier. After a year of discernment, we have previously made the decision to raze the building and sell the land. We are in the final stages of a contract with a company who will start the

demolition later this month. It will last throughout much of the summer. It's a long process to make sure it's done safely and well with regard for our neighbors in that area.

Once the old church is down and cleared, the land will be prepared to be sold. We are also in the process of choosing a national real estate company that will help us sell it for an appropriate price. This money will come back to the parish to help with current and future needs including helping to pay down our existing debt on the new building. Our current building debt stands at \$666,526 (as of 2-28-2024).

What a gift it will be when we are debt free and money currently being spent on interest payments is put away for future use for the building and for evangelization.

As always, please let me know if you have any questions or concerns. You'll start to see some construction traffic at the old church very soon. We are grateful to God for all the beautiful prayer and sacraments that happened there!

Estimados feligreses,

¡Bendita Cuaresma para todos! Por favor asegúrese de hacer del Sacramento de la Confesión una prioridad desde ahora hasta la Pascua. Tampoco espere hasta el último momento. Tenemos Confesiones seis días a la semana y el Centro de Estudiantes Católicos St. John también tiene un horario sólido.

Quiero dar una actualización sobre el antiguo San Francisco Javier. Después de un año de discernimiento, previamente hemos tomado la decisión de derribar el edificio y vender el terreno. Estamos en las etapas finales de un contrato con una empresa que comenzará la demolición a finales de este mes. Durará durante gran parte del verano. Es un proceso largo para garantizar que se haga de manera segura y bien con respecto a nuestros vecinos en esa área.

Una vez que la antigua iglesia esté derribada y limpiada, el terreno estará preparado para ser vendido. También estamos en el proceso de elegir una inmobiliaria nacional que nos ayude a venderlo a un precio adecuado. Este dinero regresará a la parroquia para ayudar con las necesidades actuales y futuras, incluida la ayuda para pagar nuestra deuda existente sobre el nuevo edificio. Nuestra deuda de construcción actual asciende a \$666,526 (al 28 de febrero de 2024).

¡Qué regalo será cuando estemos libres de deudas y el dinero que se gasta en pagos de intereses se guarde para uso futuro en la construcción y la evangelización!

Como siempre, avíseme si tiene alguna pregunta o inquietud. Muy pronto empezará a ver algo de tráfico en obras en la antigua iglesia. ¡Estamos agradecidos con Dios por todas las hermosas oraciones y sacramentos que sucedieron allí!

A Reflection on the Gospel

“One thing I do know: I was blind, and now I see.”

“I sure wish Jesus would do something like that for me,” you might say. “If only He would change my life...then I would believe Him, trust Him more fully.” Sure, I believe He can heal the blind in Bible stories, but my own blindness? My family? My boss or coworkers? What about the real pain and hurt I’ve experienced--why did it have to happen? And if it’s really “so that the works of God might be made visible through me,” then why doesn’t God just do that already?

God is glorified more by our loving trust than by anything else we could do or say. Nothing delights Him more than our childlike heart saying, “I belong to You, Lord, just as I am, in this moment and in no other.” Pride and self-reliance are the cataracts which He is removing. That’s why the beggar’s response is so faithful, so simple. He doesn’t waste his time trying to figure out why God allowed his blindness, or why the same God healed it. He just worships and witnesses: “One thing I know: I was blind, and now I see.”

Ever since Eden, our greatest blind spot is ourselves. Sin shames us into compulsively hiding ourselves. That’s why, this week, my invitation is to ask Jesus to reveal you to yourself. Let Him show you the roots of your vices and bad habits, the areas of being unloved, unwanted, uncared for, forgotten. Live in the freedom of one who is seen as God sees.

“Una cosa sí sé: era ciego y ahora veo”.

“Me gustaría que Jesús hiciera algo así por mí”, podrías decir. “Si tan solo Él cambiara mi vida... entonces le creería y confiaría más plenamente en Él”. Claro, creo que Él puede sanar a los ciegos en las historias bíblicas, pero ¿mi propia ceguera? ¿Mi familia? ¿Mi jefe o mis compañeros de trabajo? ¿Qué pasa con el dolor real que he experimentado? ¿Por qué tuvo que suceder? Y si realmente es “para que las obras de Dios se hagan visibles a través de mí”, entonces ¿por qué Dios no lo hace ya?

Dios es glorificado más por nuestra amorosa confianza que por cualquier otra cosa que podamos hacer o decir. Nada le deleita más que nuestro corazón de niño que dice: “Te pertenezco, Señor, tal como soy, en este momento y en ningún otro”. El orgullo y la confianza en uno mismo son las cataratas que Él está quitando. Por eso la respuesta del mendigo es tan fiel, tan sencilla. No pierde el tiempo tratando de descubrir por qué Dios permitió su ceguera o por qué el mismo Dios la sanó. Él simplemente adora y testifica: “Una cosa sé: fui ciego y ahora veo”.

Desde el Edén, nuestro mayor punto ciego somos nosotros mismos. El pecado nos avergüenza hasta el punto de escondernos compulsivamente. Por eso, esta semana mi invitación es a pedirle a Jesús que te revele a ti mismo. Deja que Él te muestre las raíces de tus vicios y malos hábitos, las áreas en las que no eres amado, no deseado, desatendido y olvidado. Viva en la libertad de quien es visto como Dios ve.




A ROSARY WALK THROUGH LENT
