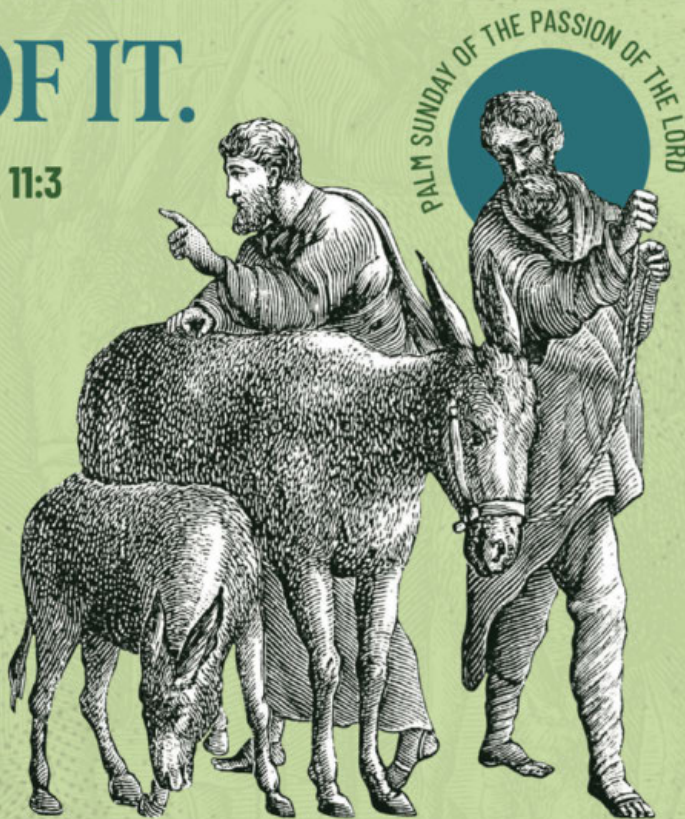

What is it and is it accredited?

St. Isidore of Seville Catholic Virtual School is a full time, K-12, tuition free, online Catholic charter school in the state of Oklahoma. Yes, St. Isidore of Seville Catholic Virtual School is accredited by the Accreditation Standards Division of the Oklahoma State Department of Education.

Who is eligible to apply?

Any student eligible for Kindergarten to grade twelve of any faith or no faith, living in Oklahoma is enrollment. It recommended that parents read carefully the handbook issued during seat acceptance and registration process.

Who are the teachers?

Our teachers are passionate educators from all corners of Oklahoma and the United States who care about children having opportunity to experience an excellent education rich in Catholic intellectual tradition.

How can I apply for registration for my child?

The Application Portal will open on March 1, 2024 and can be found on the website landing page at siscvs.org. Applications will be reviewed and a request to accept the seat and complete registration paperwork will be sent. Families will have 5 days to accept their offered seat. Should applications exceed our 500 student cap, a lottery will be conducted on April 4. Those accepted via the lottery will be sent the link to accept their seat and to complete registration paperwork.

¿Quién es elegible para aplicar?

Cualquier estudiante elegible para el jardín de infantes hasta el grado doce de cualquier fe o no, que viva en Oklahoma está inscrito. Recomendó que los padres lean atentamente el manual emitido durante el proceso de aceptación y registro de asientos.

Si las solicitudes exceden nuestro límite de 500 estudiantes, se llevará a cabo una lotería el 4 de abril. A los aceptados a través de la lotería se les enviará el enlace para aceptar su asiento y completar la documentación de inscripción.

A Reflection on the Gospel

A lot is happening in today's Gospel of Mark for Psalm Sunday. Throughout this Gospel, Jesus walks together with his disciples, trying to prepare them for what is to come. Each character is essential as Jesus prepares to die. The woman who gave what she had and anointed Jesus, and Jesus says, "anticipated anointing my body for burial." Behind Jesus' back, Judas plots to betray Jesus in exchange for earthly wealth. Jesus instructs the disciples to go to the Master's house to prepare a room for Passover. Jesus starts by telling (knowing) that one of the disciples will betray him; even though they reassure him, they will not. Yet even knowing this, Jesus continues to make a covenant with his people of Thanksgiving, Eucharistic (Greek). Jesus then takes the Disciples to the Mount of Olives, where he warns his disciples that "all of you will have your faith shaken." Peter speaks up to proclaim his faith will not, and Jesus answers, "This very night before the cock crows twice, you will deny me three times." Jesus and the disciples arrive at the place of Gethsemane, where Jesus tells his disciples, "My soul is sorrowful even to death. Remain here and keep watch." The devil tempts Jesus, yet Jesus prays so fervently that he sweats blood. Jesus, with his Divine Knowledge, knows and accepts the cross that he will bear out of love for us. Soldiers arrest Jesus; he gets put on trial, beaten, and scourged, women following along the way (Mother Mary among them); several people convert the good thief and the Centurion, and then Jesus dies on the cross. Joseph of Arimathea offers a place of burial for Jesus' body in the tomb.

Palm Sunday, during this last week in Lent, is a time we continue to walk with Jesus. In the Gospel of Mark chapter 14, we begin to have an understanding of why Jesus comes in human form. Lent is a time for repentance, prayer, and almsgiving. In her wisdom, the church encourages this, especially during this time, because it helps us grow a deeper understanding of what it means to be a disciple and, we can grow closer in relationship to God. Who do you relate to in this Gospel reading? What can we learn from them? All who follow Jesus are sinners, but Jesus dies on the cross knowing and loving each and everyone of us! Let us continue to walk with Jesus and prepare our hearts to love him with everything we can offer to Him. Jesus has given you everything you need to pick up your cross and follow him.

Iesum milites comprehenderunt; in probatione, flagellatur et flagellatur, sequuntur in via. plures convertunt bonum latronem et centurionem, et tunc moritur Iesus in cruce. Ioseph ab Arimathaea corpus Iesu in sepulcro offert sepulturae.

Cum Iesu pergamus ambulare et corda nostra praeprare ut illum diligamus in omnibus quae Ipsi offerimus. Iesus tibi dedit omnia quae debes tollere crucem tuam et sequere eum.

March is Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month

Colorectal Cancer Facts

- In 2024, an estimated 152,810 people will be diagnosed with colorectal cancer in the U.S.
- Unlike most cancers, colorectal cancer is highly preventable with screening. Localized colorectal cancer (the earliest stage) has a 91% five-year survival rate with treatment.
- The most common symptom of colorectal cancer is no symptom. When symptoms are present, they may include blood in or on stool, persistent abdominal discomfort, and unexplained weight loss.
- The incidence rate of young-onset colorectal cancer is rising. In people under 55 years old, the incidence rate is increasing by 1% - 2% every year.
- Colorectal cancer screening should begin at age 45. Screening is the No. 1 way to prevent colorectal cancer.
- The CDC estimated that 68% of colorectal cancer deaths could be prevented if all eligible people were screened. Members of the public can get a free screening recommendation based on personal risk factors at quiz.getscreened.org.
- People who have a first-degree relative (parent, sibling, offspring) with colorectal cancer have two to four times the risk of developing the disease.
- Simple ways to reduce the risk of colorectal cancer include eating healthy, not smoking, exercising regularly, maintaining a healthy weight, limiting red meat intake, and adding calcium and vitamin D to your diet.

Marzo es el Mes de Concientización Sobre el Cáncer Colorrectal

Datos sobre el cáncer colorrectal

- En 2024, se estima que 152,810 personas serán diagnosticadas con cáncer colorrectal en los EE. UU.
- A diferencia de la mayoría de los cánceres, el cáncer colorrectal se puede prevenir en gran medida mediante pruebas de detección. El cáncer colorrectal localizado (la etapa más temprana) tiene una tasa de supervivencia a cinco años del 91% con tratamiento.
- El síntoma más común del cáncer colorrectal es ningún síntoma. Cuando los síntomas están presentes, pueden incluir sangre en las heces, malestar abdominal persistente y pérdida de peso inexplicable.
- La tasa de incidencia del cáncer colorrectal de aparición temprana está aumentando. En personas menores de 55 años, la tasa de incidencia aumenta entre un 1% y un 2% cada año.
- Las pruebas de detección del cáncer colorrectal deben comenzar a los 45 años. Las pruebas de detección son la forma número uno de prevenir el cáncer colorrectal.
- Los CDC estimaron que el 68% de las muertes por cáncer colorrectal podrían prevenirse si todas las personas elegibles se sometieran a pruebas de detección. Los miembros del público pueden obtener una recomendación de detección gratuita basada en factores de riesgo personales en quiz.getscreened.org.
- Las personas que tienen un familiar de primer grado (padre, hermano, descendencia) con cáncer colorrectal tienen de dos a cuatro veces más riesgo de desarrollar la enfermedad.
- Formas sencillas de reducir el riesgo de cáncer colorrectal incluyen comer sano, no fumar, hacer ejercicio con regularidad, mantener un peso saludable, limitar el consumo de carnes rojas y agregar calcio y vitamina D a su dieta.

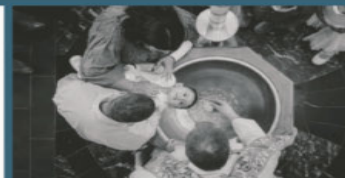
