A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR / UNA NOTA DE NUESTRO PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

During the time between Fr. O'Brien's departure and Fr. Lawrence's coming, we are full steam ahead! God in his providence has seen to it that Fr. O'Brien's mission to evangelize Payne County can continue even during his absence, while he remains the canonical pastor of our parish. I would like to share with you some thoughts as to the nature of my role during the next two and a half months as associate pastor, or parochial vicar (the term in the Church's Canon Law). A parochial vicar is not just a second priest in

residence in a parish; he is a priest who acts in union with, and under the mission of the pastor. And consequently, he carries the authority of the pastor when he does things, because he is an extension of the pastor, in a manner of speaking. The pastor acts through him, in the full sense of the term, "vicariously."

For the last two years, this has been my role, and it continues to be my role in the parish: to use my own creativity and energy to further the pastor's mission. This is so there is one captain of the ship, and when the captain is absent, his leadership is able to continue. I am very grateful to have been able to work with, learn from, and be formed by Fr. O'Brien for the last two years, as a pastor-in-training, and I am grateful for this time to be able to put that training to use. Please be patient with me, as I take the helm.

I would like to encourage all of us to see this time not as an interim, but as a time for plowing forward, and doing the Lord's work with might and main. This is not, nor cannot be, a matter of merely human effort, like trying to grow a business or sell more used cars. A parish exists for a mission: to proclaim repentance and faith in Jesus Christ to the people within its territorial boundary, and first of all, that is to ourselves! If we aren't learning, if we aren't engaging, if we aren't putting our faith into action, we can't give that faith to others. May God give to me and to you the grace to use this time profitably!

Estimados feligreses,

Durante el tiempo entre la partida del Padre O'Brien y la venida del Padre Lawrence, estamos echándole ganas y ¡seguiremos adelante! Dios en su providencia se ha encargado de que el Padre O'Brien pueda continuar con su misión de evangelizar al condado de Payne incluso durante su ausencia, mientras siga siendo el pastor canónico de nuestra parroquia.

Me gustaría compartir con ustedes algunas ideas sobre mi función durante los próximos dos meses y medio como pastor asociado, o vicario parroquial (el término en el Canon de la Iglesia Ley.) Un vicario parroquial no es simplemente un segundo sacerdote residente; es un sacerdote que actúa en unión y bajo la misión del pastor. Y en consecuencia, lleva la autoridad del pastor cuando hace las cosas, porque es una extensión del pastor, por así decirlo. El pastor actúa a través de él, en el pleno sentido del término, "vicariamente."

Durante los últimos dos años, este ha sido mi papel y sigue siendo mi papel en la parroquia: Usar mi propia creatividad y energía para promover la misión del pastor. Esto es así para que haya un capitán del barco, y cuando el capitán está ausente, su liderazgo pueda continuar. Estoy muy agradecido de haber podido trabajar, aprender y ser formado por el Padre O'Brien durante los últimos dos años como pastor en formación, y estoy agradecido por este tiempo de poder poner en práctica esa formación. Por favor, tengan paciencia conmigo mientras tomo las riendas.

Me gustaría animarnos a todos a que consideramos este momento no como un período intermedio, sino como un momento para avanzar y hacer la obra del Señor con todas sus fuerzas. Esto no es ni puede ser una cuestión de esfuerzo meramente humano, como intentar hacer crecer un negocio o vender más autos usados. Una parroquia existe para una misión: proclamar el arrepentimiento y la fe en Jesucristo a las personas dentro de su límite territorial, y en primer lugar, ¡eso es hacia nosotros mismos! Si no estamos aprendiendo, si no lo estamos atrayendo, si no ponemos nuestra fe en acción, no podemos dar esa fe a los demás

A Reflection on the Gospel

Last week Peter is giving the people and explanatory speech about the healing of the man who was cripple since birth. This week, his speech to the elders and leaders of the people about the same healing is confrontational. He repeats words we hear often in scripture and song "He is the stone rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone." After pausing on this sentence, can you see how it may apply to your life today? Have you rejected Jesus, putting people, places or things of this world before him? Is he your cornerstone, turning to him when pain and suffering enter your life? Is He your cornerstone? While this point may be hard to swallow, do not despair. The Entrance Antiphon says "the merciful love of the Lord fills the earth." That is a promise that cannot be ignored. In addition, the Collect today can open the door of our hearts even further, "Almighty ever-living God, lead us to a share in the joys of heaven..."

Furthermore, the joyous message of the season is being reinforced in the 2nd reading. John says, "Beloved, we are God's children now." Jesus is the "only Son" of the Father by nature, but we are sons and daughters of the Father as believers, by divine adoption. We are entitled to His love and protection, He gives us graces, and through the water and Spirit of Baptism are empowered to love others as Jesus did. In the Prayer Over the Offerings it says, "The whole Church prays that the renewal constantly at work with us may be the cause of our unending joy." We are being invited to continue seeking a closer relationship with God our Father and Jesus his Son and the promise is to live the joy of the season all year long because their merciful love not only fills the earth, but is waiting to fill our hearts.

Let us pray, Dear Heavenly Father, I desire to know you more and ask that you help me open my heart to you in blind trust, even if it is in baby steps. Amen.

Una Reflexión Sobre el Evangelio

La semana pasada Pedro dio al pueblo un discurso explicativo sobre la curación del hombre que estaba cojo de nacimiento. Esta semana, su discurso ante los ancianos y líderes del pueblo sobre la misma curación es confrontativo. Él repite palabras que escuchamos a menudo en las Escrituras y en las canciones: "Él es la piedra que desechasteis vosotros, los constructores, y que se ha convertido en piedra angular". Después de hacer una pausa en esta frase, ¿puedes ver cómo se puede aplicar a tu vida hoy? ¿Has rechazado a Jesús, anteponiendo a personas, lugares o cosas de este mundo? ¿Es él tu piedra angular, recurriendo a él cuando el dolor y el sufrimiento entran en tu vida? ¿Es Él tu piedra angular? Si bien este punto puede resultar difícil de aceptar, no se desespere. La Antífona de Entrada dice "el amor misericordioso del Señor llena la tierra". Esa es una promesa que no se puede ignorar. Además, la colecta de hoy puede abrir aún más la puerta de nuestro corazón: "Dios todopoderoso y eterno, guíanos. para compartir las alegrías del cielo..."

Además, el alegre mensaje de la temporada se refuerza en la segunda lectura. Juan dice: "Amados, ahora somos hijos de Dios". Jesús es el "Hijo único" del Padre por naturaleza, pero nosotros somos hijos e hijas del Padre como creyentes, por adopción divina. Tenemos derecho a Su amor y protección, Él nos da gracias y, a través del agua y el Espíritu del Bautismo, tenemos el poder de amar a los demás como lo hizo Jesús. En la Oración sobre las Ofrendas dice: "Toda la Iglesia ora para que la renovación que obra constantemente con nosotros sea la causa de nuestro gozo interminable". Estamos siendo invitados a seguir buscando una relación más cercana con Dios nuestro Padre y Jesús su Hijo y la promesa es vivir la alegría de la estación durante todo el año porque su amor misericordioso no solo llena la tierra, sino que está esperando llenar nuestros corazones.

Oremos, Querido Padre Celestial, deseo conocerte más y te pido que me ayudes a abrirte mi corazón con una confianza ciega, aunque sea a pequeños pasos. Amén.

What is SoonerSelect?

SoonerSelect is a new health care delivery system that provides Medicaid health benefits through contracted arrangements between state Medicaid agencies, health plans and dental plans.

SoonerSelect replaces SoonerCare for most eligible Oklahomans, including:

- Children, including foster children
- Low-income parents
- Pregnant women
- Non-disabled adults ages 19-64

SoonerSelect is designed to provide the same health care services previously received through SoonerCare. This means members should not experience any loss or change in benefits. Some SoonerSelect plans may even offer additional benefits to help you improve your health.

Visit the SoonerSelect website- www.oklahoma.gov/ohca/soonerselect to view health plans, compare benefits and search providers. You can choose between three health plans: Aetna Better Health of Oklahoma, Humana Healthy Horizons of Oklahoma and Oklahoma Complete Health.

You can pick between two dental plans: DentaQuest or LIBERTY Dental. Your dental plan provides medically necessary cleanings, preventive and restorative care, and provides medically necessary orthodontic services for children under 21.

¿Qué es SoonerSelect?

SoonerSelect es un nuevo sistema de prestación de atención médica que brinda beneficios de salud de Medicaid a través de acuerdos contractuales entre agencias estatales de Medicaid, planes de salud y planes dentales.

SoonerSelect reemplaza a SoonerCare para la mayoría de los habitantes de Oklahoma elegibles, incluidos:

- Niños, incluidos los niños de crianza
- Padres de bajos ingresos
- Mujeres embarazadas
- Adultos no discapacitados de 19 a 64 años

SoonerSelect está diseñado para brindar los mismos servicios de atención médica recibidos anteriormente a través de SoonerCare. Esto significa que los miembros no deberían experimentar ninguna pérdida o cambio en los beneficios. Algunos planes SoonerSelect pueden incluso ofrecer beneficios adicionales para ayudarlo a mejorar su salud.

Puede elegir entre dos planes dentales: DentaQuest o LIBERTY Dental. Su plan dental brinda limpiezas, atención preventiva y de restauración médicamente necesarias, y brinda servicios de ortodoncia médicamente necesarios para niños menores de 21 años.

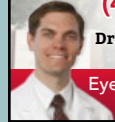

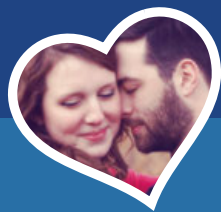
